

## Prerequisite


- Bamboo HR is created
- Evolia Account is created
- Evolia account is subscribed to Business plan

## Initial Setup

From the Settings page, the administrator opens the "Integrations" page from the "Modules and Integrations" section.





## Request Integration Service


Next to Bamboo HR integration, the administrator clicks on the "Request Integration Service" button. This notifies Evolia of the integration request. Once the initial configuration is completed Evolia, will notify the requester via email.

## Complete Account Setup

Once the configuration is complete, the login button is available. When the administrator hits the login button, Bamboo HR login page is shown. The user is invited to login in using an administrator account to complete the initial account setup.




\*Employee synchronization is triggered every 4 hours automatically. However it is possible to trigger it manually by following the steps below..



## Optional Step




Open to the employee view. To trigger manually an employee synchronization, select "Synchronize employees" action.






## Confirmation Snackbar
